	Class 21	Matching pair of Beeswax Candles, moulded (one candle will be lit for judging)
	Class 22	Matching pair of Beeswax Candles, made by any method other than moulding (one candle will be lit for judging)
	Class 23	One Beeswax Flower, displayed in a vase.
	Class 24	Cake of Beeswax, plainly moulded. Target weight 8oz. (227g) plus or minus 10%
	Class 25	One bottle of Mead, not less than 500ml, in a plain bottle of clear glass.
Confectionery	Class 26	Greek Honey Drizzle Cake (see Recipes)
	Class 27	Honey and Fruit Cake (see Recipes)
	Class 28	Honey and Ginger Snap Biscuits (see Recipes)
	Class 29	Honey Fudge - display eight pieces (see Recipes)
